Recovery Coaching is a new and exciting frontier in the field of addiction services. The CCAR Recovery Coach Academy will be hosted by the Message Carriers of Pennsylvania, Inc. This is an opportunity for individuals to learn to work with recoverees to promote recovery, remove barriers, connect people with recovery support services and encourage hope, optimism and healthy living.

The academy focus is on the distinct differences between a counselor, Recovery Coach and sponsor; the Stages of Change through which a Recovery Coach can assist recoverees, Boundary Issues, Ethics, Guiding Principles and Core Values of Recovery, Self-Disclosure.
